English: We will continue to extend our understanding of sentence structure and grammar, learn new spellings and apply learnt rules. We will be looking at journalistic writing, learn about different types of poetry and apply our skills over a range of writing. Our class text continues to be 1000 Year Old Boy by Ross Welford.

Science: We will be learning about Earth and Space. The children will have an awareness of Earth and their place on Earth. They will have an understanding of the planets and the wider galaxy. They will cover history of Space/famous Scientists and astronauts/locations around the world important to space travel/the space race/cover measure, volume and many other aspects of maths through space research. They will carry out their own space investigations in different conditions.

Computing: We will continue to develop our understanding of how we can keep ourselves safe when using technology. Online safety is our focus. We will also be looking at Powerpoint/Publisher and Word.

PE: We will develop our dance skills through the Big Dance sessions, preparing and practising for our stage performance later in the year. We will also be doing Hockey.
