- Present information in a variety of ways to inform audiences of our findings

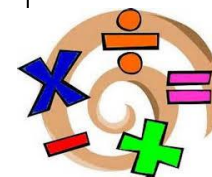
Science:

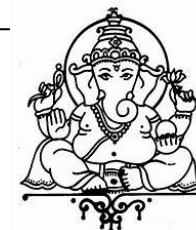
