

English - We will have regular phonics and grammar sessions; learn common spellings and practise cursive handwriting. We will be looking at fairy tales. We will read and perform poetry based five senses. We will write lists, captions and label diagrams. We will read and write non-fiction texts about the Great Fire of London and create simple diaries. We will listen to and retell stories relating to fire.

Music – We will sing Harvest hymns and Christmas carols; listen to and create fire music; use the terms ‘pitch, tempo and dynamics’.



RE – Harvest Festival; Christian Church, prayers, Advent, angels and the Nativity story.

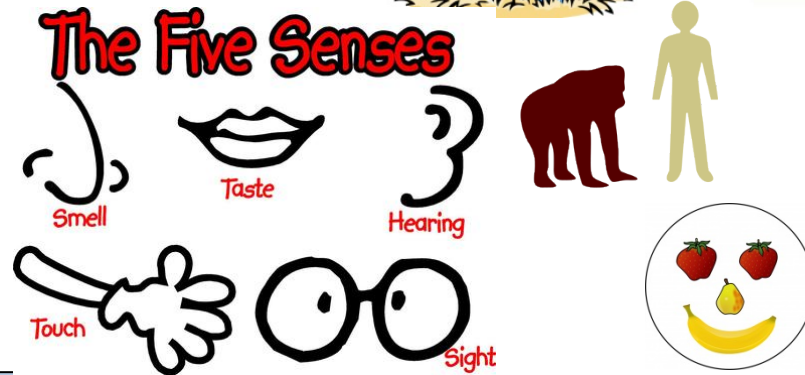
Maths – We will be counting confidently forwards and back in 1s, 2s, 5s, 10s; understanding and comparing the value of 2-digit numbers; calculating addition and subtraction by counting on and back; learning the numbers that make 5, 10, 20; learning to tell the time to the hour, ½ and ¼ past.

Humanities – We will learn about the Great Fire of London and compare fire-fighting in 1666 to that of today. We will locate the capital city of England and Punnetts Town on a map of the UK. We will begin to recognise some London landmarks.

Science – We will learn more about animals including humans. We will investigate our senses and learn about parts of the body. We will classify and compare the structure of animals. We will continue to become more aware of seasonal changes.

Computing - We will learn about the need for e-safety, consider technology in our everyday lives, develop keyboard and paint skills to present ideas and learn that devices are controlled by sequences of actions or instructions.

PE- Multi-skills, ball skills, dance, team games



PSHE – working as a team and part of a community; our role in class and within the school; right and wrong, fair and unfair, likes and dislikes.

Art & DT – We will create portraits and patterns with different media and methods. We will be inspired by the artist Arcimboldo. As designers we will learn about Tudor houses and create a moving part using levers. We will create healthy sandwiches and make Christmas decorations.
