**Little Punnetts Class:** In Little Punnetts class this term, our topic is colour. The children have been learning all about the artist Kandinsky, whose inspiration for painting came from the emotions he

felt from listening to music. The children have been looking at some of his art work and have been re-creating his style of art with some great results.

This week has been road safety week. The children have been looking at the importance of being safe when crossing the road as well as how to keep yourself safe in the car.

The children have been engaging with the outside equipment. They have

been thoroughly enjoying creating their own concoctions in the mud kitchen, with mud

pies and mud soups a plenty. They have been adventuring out on the climbing frame and balancing beams, putting their motor skills to work!

All the children settled back into nursery well, and have experienced a fun filled few weeks!
