They live in tribes. Some tribes designed and created totem poles in the places they lived. Totem poles showed images of animals living in the same area and other important symbols. Most had an eagle at the top. Design your own totem pole to represent where you live and things that are important to you.	Make a collection of natural objects mixing their subtle colours and details in a natural collage. Use a magnifying glass to help you look at the smaller areas of colour and pattern. Items might include flowers, leaves, stones and pebbles, shells and tree bark.
