Phonics

Year 1 will be securing their knowledge of phonics taught so far enabling them to decode real and not real words and recognise Year 1 common exception words by sight. Year 2 will be continuing to learn about 'best fit' rules for long vowels and vowel digraphs and trigraphs.

Reading – we will be learning the skill of sequencing and summarising and explaining.

Writing – We will be reading 'art themed' stories that will help us to fine tune the technical aspects of our writing like using simple punctuation and applying the spelling rules we have learnt so far. We will be writing persuasive letters and recounts.

Science

Observe the seasons – Spring & Summer Everyday Materials and their Uses – Identify and name a number of different objects and the materials from which they are made. Classify and describe objects and record their physical properties. Perform simple tests to understand how materials change when heated, cooled, stretched, put in water, bounced.

Create and conduct a survey about the uses of wooden objects. Create an experiment to determine how flexible objects are. Design a toy with different suitable materials and evaluate the design.
